ID Cards

For security reasons, students, faculty members, and administrators are to wear their college ID cards on campus, and they must be visible at all times. The security and safety department also manages the visitor ID cards that are given out at the security guard stations at the school gates. Access to the college campus will be barred if an ID card is not displayed or presented at request. Parents and guardians are also provided with ID cards while visiting the college campus.

VIGIL

We have the latest standards of safeguarding policies, placing a huge value on student safety and protection. Our college community implements campuswide safety measures, including student safeguarding procedures and policies, to help protect our students and keep them safe.

College Rules & Regulations

- Every student and their parent will have to sign in agreement the undertaking framed by the college as rules and regulations for the students.
- •Every student must follow punctuality according to the prescribed timetable. Timetable is subject to revision from time to time and the changes must be adhered to.
- •Wearing the individual identity card is a must for on campus presence for all the persons present, be they students, teachers, administrative personnel or supporting staff. The college authorities reserve the sole right, at their discretion, to bar entry to the campus of any such defaulter.
- •Vandalizing, inflicting damage or defacement to any college property will incur proportional compensatory punishment for the perpetrator as adjudicated by the disciplinary committee.
- •Proper dress code, as prescribed, must be followed by all those who will come under the purview of such prescriptions.
- •A minimum of 85 percent attendance per semester is mandatory for a student. An inducement of up to 5 marks is provided based on fulfilment of individual attendance levels.
- •There is no provision for a reassessment for the absentee from any written or practical assessment.
- •Students will have to mandatorily write the class tests and complete assignments from time to time as instructed.
- •Any student found guilty of any aspect of untoward behaviour on the campus, like physical or psychological ragging or manhandling, verbal or actional misbehaviour, may be subjected to bear the consequences as per the provisions of the UGC Regulations as well as the law and rules in force.
